

STIBET Scholarship for Special Commitment

Scholarship and Support Program of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)

Who can apply?

International students of the OTH Regensburg in Bachelor's and Master's degree programme with outstanding commitment in an international context

Who can't apply?

- International students with several nationalities, if one of them is German
- Exchange students
- Applicants (applicants for a study place at OTH Regensburg who are not yet enrolled at OTH Regensburg)

Funding amount

Students with a STIBET full scholarship receive up to 934 euros per month. In addition, they may earn up to 520 euros gross. If the additional income exceeds this amount, the scholarship will be reduced accordingly so that the total amount of the scholarship and additional income does not exceed 1,454 euros per month.

Important: Payment of the full scholarship amount is not guaranteed. The amount of the scholarship is adjusted to the available funds.

Application requirements

- Good academic performance (minimum grade point average of 3.0 or better)
- Outstanding commitment in an international context (also voluntary work)
- No other scholarships during the funding period (regardless of the type and amount of the scholarship payments)
- Enrollment during the funding period
- No permanent stay outside their place of study (exception: stays abroad are possible as part of a compulsory stay in accordance with the study regulations)

Application deadlines

April 15 for the summer semester October 15 for the winter semester
